I confirm that I am a UK Taxpayer and that I will advise RBMIND if this situation changes. I understand that I must pay an amount of Income Tax or Capital Gains Tax in the relevant year equal to any tax reclaimed by RBMIND in that period.

To be eligible for Gift Aid you must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that RBMIND reclaims on your donations in the tax year. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self-Assessment tax return.

If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the Charity reclaims, you can cancel your Declaration.

If you wish to cancel your Declaration at any time, simply notify RBMIND. We will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of the cancellation or such later date as you may specify.

If your Declaration covers donations you may make in the future, please notify RBMIND if you change your name or address while the Declaration is still in force.

If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, please ask RBMIND or ask your local tax office and ask for leaflet IR113 Gift Aid.
